Minutes of the meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2015 were proposed by Anthea Prescot, seconded by Sue Laing and approved unanimously, no amendments being made.

## 1. Matters Arising:

a) Election of Officers: Treasurer – Nigel Gray was proposed by Anthony West and seconded by Anthea Prescot. All in favour.

**Secretary** – Ruth Palethorpe was proposed by Anthony West and seconded by Leslie Prescot. All in favour.

#### b) Church Organist:

Gary Seiling has agreed to the terms of the contract drawn up by Charlotte Every which will commence 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015.

### c) Church Organ:

Fr Martyn has been in touch with the original manufacturers of the church organ, Walkers, to request an estimate for the repair.

### 2. Finance Report:

Nigel Gray shared the receipts and payments balance sheet from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> April with the committee. The Treasurer commented the overall deficit was similar to the same period last year but pointed out church collections were up.

#### 3. Parish Hall

Father Martyn advised the Parish Hall Committee had agreed to the purchase of a defibrillator. The Rector advised the cost of repairing/replacing segments of the Parish Hall wall was discussed by the Committee these could exceed £20,000. The appropriate government conservation department would need to be advised.

## 4. Any other Business

## a) Churchyard Maintenance

Mr Symes advised he wishes to increase his rate from £15.00 to £16.00 per man-hour, this would bring the overall cost of churchyard maintenance to £5000.00, an increase of £300.00.

Nigel Gray mentioned some of members of the congregation had commented/complained regarding untidiness/disarray in the Upper Churchyard. This problem needs to be resolved as soon as possible.
