**Annex 1  
Mandatory Conditions**

**Mandatory Condition - exhibition of films**

- 1) admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with the following:
- 2) where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless subsection(3)(b) applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made by that body
- 3) where -
  - (a) the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
  - (b) the relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question,
- admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority

**Mandatory Condition - door supervisors**  
door supervisors must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority

**Annex 2  
Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

**a) General**

Remenham Parish Hall is a village hall in which activities/functions for the local community take place, as well as it being hired out in order to generate income for its maintenance.  
It is managed by the Remenham Parish hall Committee which varies in size but always includes a Chairman (nominated by the Parochial Church Council of St Nicholas, Remenham), Treasurer and Secretary.  
The Committee is applying for a Premises Licence to include regulated entertainment but excluding the sale of alcohol.  
On any occasion when alcohol is to be sold, an application will be made by the organiser of the event for a TEN (up to the allowed maximum of 12 in any calendar year).

**b) Prevention of Crime and Disorder**

By the engendering of a good community spirit, within the Parish.  
Use of the Parish Hall for both parish events and private lettings, is controlled by, and at the discretion of, the Parish Hall Committee.

**c) Public Safety**

The Parish hall has recently been refurbished to required Health & Safety standards.  
The fire extinguishers are serviced every 12 months (see premises plan for positioning of extinguishers, Fire Exits etc.) and all the electrical appliances are checked annually by a local electrical contractor.  
No fireworks are permitted inside the building and the use of fireworks outdoors will be limited to Parish events.

**d) Prevention of Public Nuisance**

Conditions:

1a) All sound from the premises shall be inaudible at any point on the boundary of the site before 12.00hrs or after 23.00 hours (Mon-Sat), 22.30 hours on a Sunday.

1b) All licensable activities on the premises shall be adequately controlled to ensure the A-weighted equivalent continuous noise level (LAeq) when measured over any 2 minute period at any point on the boundary of the site between 12.00 hours and 23.00 hours (Mon-Sat) and 22.30 hours Sunday does not increase by more than 3dBA when compared to the same measure, from the same position and over a comparable period when the licensable activity is not taking place.

1c) All licensable activity on the premises shall be adequately controlled to ensure the un-weighted equivalent continuous noise level (Leq) in the 63 Hz octave band and in the 125 Hz octave band, when measured over any 2 minute period at any point on the boundary of the site between 12.00 hours and 23.00 hours (Mon-Sat) and 22.30 hours Sunday, does not show any increase when compared to the same measure, from the same position and over a comparable period when the licensable activity is not taking place.

2 The Premises are not to be used for more than 28 days of music/noise related regulated entertainment, in any calendar year, including those authorised by Temporary Event Notices ("TENS").

3 The provisions contained in this Section d (Prevention of Public Nuisance) shall apply equally to any activity permitted by TENS.

All lettings are controlled by the Parish Hall Committee which is made up of local residents under the chairmanship of a member of Remenham Parochial Church Council.

The attention of all hirers is drawn, when completing their booking form, to the Conditions of the Premises licence (a copy of which is displayed in the hall), in particular to the Section P(d) 1a, b and c, which relates to noise levels and times.

On departure at the end of the evening, everyone is requested to leave quietly with due consideration for the neighbours.
