033/26: APOLOGIES AND WELCOMES

There were no apologies for absence. BR welcomed NA, MG and NH and residents to the meeting.

034/26: DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

035/26: MINUTES OF THE MEETING held on 9th March 2026. These were approved by the meeting and signed by BR.

036/26: ACTIONS & MATTERS ARISING

TC reported that all actions had been completed. He announced that the forthcoming election would be uncontested.

037/26: FINANCE & ACCOUNT ACTIVITY

Account activity had been circulated (including 3 parking signs £2034.00, PH Ferry Lane field gate £652.31) and was approved. It was AGREED that RPC would pay for (if acceptable) 2 hanging baskets for Hambleden Lock and Marsh Lock and one for the Parish Hall. The Clerk's expenses in delivering forms to WBC were approved.

038/26: LICENSING, EVENTS & CIA

BR invited NA, MG and NH to describe their upcoming 2026 events and said RPC was trying ensure there no negative impacts of events. It was AGREED that event details (e.g.

would be available to The Clerk to go on the website for the benefit of residents (and thereby helping event organizers). The availability of residents vehicle permits was discussed. EA suggested there might be GDPR issues on residents signing for the passes, giving their addresses in a book. BR said he had attended HRR SAG meeting and there might be conflicts on resident's vehicle passes. TC asked that the meeting thanked HRC for accepting a traffic monitor near their entrance on the A321. This was AGREED.

039/26: PLANNING

It was AGREED that RPC would ask Andy Meader to advise on Bird Place and Atlanta applications. Work at Toll Gate Cottage was briefly discussed. Enforcement notices on boats moored near Remenham Farm was now underway.

040/26: WEBSITE

Website activity in March 2026 was noted.


041/26: TOWPATH, FOOTPATHS, TRAFFIC & HIGHWAYS

There was a discussion on traffic speeds on the 5 Remenham roads and accidents, damage to property and injuries and how best to combat this. It was felt that (i) RPC should ensure it collected sufficient speed data (not just vehicle numbers) and (ii) in conjunction with WBC and TV police there should be a request for a speed camera on the A4130 and a hand-held speed camera. TC said hand-held cameras had been tested in Remenham 2 years ago.
